

REVAMP Africa is working with public secondary schools across the six geopolitical zones in Nigeria and countries in Africa, whilst in view of pursuing/working with private secondary schools whose facilities and professional exposure is not of the accepted standard.

Since its inception, REVAMP Africa has facilitated leadership and academic interventions in 58 schools, across twenty eight states in Nigeria and reached directly about 108,007 students.

EXCELLENCE IN CHARACTER & ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE (ECAP)





ECAP is a high impact personal leadership programme through which REVAMP Africa provide life skills teaching and mentoring to equip underserved youths in public secondary schools.

ECAP equips students with the tools and skills required to drive improvement in their character, academic performance, interrelationship.

In a bid to also improve the reading culture, this programme is implemented via a **facilitator-led reading** and **teaching** format.

YOUNG EXCELLENT LEADERS ACADEMY (YELA)

YELA is a value-based leadership programme. It is the second level of engagement (our sustainability model) through which REVAMP Africa equips selected participants with stronger leadership skills to become peer educators and positive influencers in their schools.

It also provides a platform for young people in secondary schools to be involved actively in social impact initiatives for community development. The format makes the programme to be both activity-based and project-based learning.



SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME


The School Infrastructure Development Programme (SIDP) is a platform designed to support schools in providing conducive learning spaces for the students.

We are supporting government in ensuring that young people can learn in a suitable environment and have access to adequate reference materials for learning.

These include:

Classroom renovation and remodelling Equipping/Renovating School Libraries, etc.

In February 2020, we provided 60 new table and chairs for 120 students of Ilupeju Junior Grammar School, Lagos.







TEENS ENTERPRISE SUPPORT PROGRAMME

The TES programme develops the capacity of these underserved teenagers, who cannot further their studies for economic reasons. It equips them with some technical and soft skills to become self-employed.

These skills will give them easy access to the market, enabling them to be able to start, manage, and grow their business. The platform allows for them to become self-sufficient to pursue their dreams, continue higher education, even when there is little or no external financial support.

The TES programme approach will help these young ones gain both financial literacy and entrepreneurial skills.

OUR PARTNERSHIP

In 2017, Revamp Africa entered a partnership to impact children in secondary schools through the ProjectLEAD initiative.

In 2017, we impacted over 11,000 students in eight states in Nigeria.

In 2019/2020, our goal is to impact 90,000 students in 36 states across the country.

Facilitators will be volunteers from Revamp Africa and staff members of Access Bank Plc.

2019/2020 CSR PROGRAMME WITH ACCESS BANK PLC.



Over a 5-month period (October 2019- February 2020),

Access Bank Plc. partnered with REVAMP Africa through the ProjectLEAD initiative for the second phase of partnership.

Our sessions:

- -Highly engaging facilitator-led sessions with the students
- -Group Discussions/Presentations
- -Class Activities

Our impact spread across secondary schools in at least twenty eight states in Nigeria reaching about 90,000 students.





2019/2020 CSR PROGRAMME WITH ACCESS BANK PLC.





Each school visitation was facilitated over three to four session. Depending on the state, some were four straight days, while some others were over four weeks.

For greater effectiveness, each class had at least two facilitators – one from Access Bank RBD and the other from Revamp Africa. Each session held for 60-90 minutes during their school hours.

Various topics were taught the students and discussed during the session. They include:

- 1st Session/Week Values and Morality
- 2nd Session/Week Financial Literacy
- 3rd Session/Week Inter-personal Relationships/Class Participation
- 4th Session/Week Goal Setting & Time Management.


